



CAMPING FACT SHEET

- *Camping is available March 13th and 14th for \$20 per person, in addition to the festival ticket. The campgrounds open March 13 at 3pm and closes March 15 at 10am.
- *All camping is primitive and spots are a first come first serve bases.
- * All campers MUST be 18 years old to camp or accompanied by a Parent or LEGAL Guardian - Strictly enforced! There will be no refunds for campers who have prepaid for a camping ticket but can not provide proof of age (state issued photo ID, or passport).
- * You MUST have a festival ticket to camp. Campers will receive a wristband upon campground registration for re-entry between the festival and the campgrounds.
- * Parking is in an adjacent lot to the campgrounds. It will be a short walk (equal to a couple of city blocks) from your vehicle to your campsite. No vehicles allowed in the campgrounds.
- * No golf carts, scooters, motorcycles, all-terrain vehicles, etc.
- *COOLERS - Feel free to bring a consumable amount of food and non alcoholic beverage into the campgrounds, but unfortunately there will be NO open fires, gas, charcoal, propane or any other cooking devices allowed.
- * No alcohol, glass containers, weapons, Fire Works, drug paraphernalia, or drugs allowed.
- * There will be reasonably priced beer, wine, soft drinks, food and ice available for purchase at the campground store.
- * There will be temporary restroom facilities, but no showers.
- * The campgrounds will have lighting.
- * No animals will be allowed in the campground OR the festival.
- * The campgrounds will be staffed with security and EMT services from open until close of the campground.
- * Campers are expected to behave in a manner that is courteous to other campers.
- * Venue or producers are not responsible for any materials misplaced, lost or stolen. It is recommended you do not bring valuable items. If you do, please lock them in your car.
